- A maximum of \$300 per student will be awarded per semester toward the purchase of books or academic supplies from the campus bookstore (including supplies that the bookstore may need to order).
- Applications will be reviewed by a committee of Campus and Foundation representatives and evaluated, based on financial need.
- Grant applications** will be accepted between:
 - May 1 - August 1 for the Fall semester
 - November 1 - January 1 for the Spring semester.
- Applications must include an attached one-page personal statement of your needs and why you are applying for this grant, including financial shortfalls, health issues, etc.
